Sub. :- Regarding Guidelines for deposition of Pollution Under Control Certificate (PUCC) Fees by Auto Emission Testing Stations including Mobile AETS and realization of late Fine from applicants of P.U.C.C.

Ref. :- C.T.'s letter No. CST-MV/24/99/529/433, dtd. Guwahati the 3rd Feb. 2005 in response to the D.T.O., Kamrup (Enf) letter No. -DTK-ENF/143/03/6064-85/ dtd. 03/12/2004.

Sir,

With reference to the above, it is observed that except D.T.O., Kamrup (Enf), Guwahati, all the Auto Emission Testing Stations in the State are depositing P.U.C.C. Fees collected by them in Govt. Treasuries whereby Auto Emission Testing Stations (AETS) have faced a lot of inconveniences (such as passing the Challans by D.T.O. office & then by concerned Treasury office & finally at SBI Branch). On the other hand, while a fine is to be realised for non deposition of P.U.C.C. Fees / Non-renewal of P.U.C. Certificate in time: the applicant is directed to deposit fine in D.T.O. Office U/S- 177 of MV Act 1988 after which a P.U.C.C. applicant is entertained for renewal Fees deposition in Auto Emission Testing Station. Thus, in such cases P.U.C.C. applicant has to deposit fine at D.T.O. Office and then, the fees for P.U.C.C. fee at Auto Emission Testing Stations for entertaining the renewal / fresh issue of their P.U.C. Certificate. To overcome such inconveniences of P.U.C.C. applicant as well as inconveniences of the Auto Emission Testing Stations, the following Guidelines are formulated as under :



- 1) Hence forth, all AETS are hereby directed to deposit monthly collection of PUC fees against which a detail list of vehicles PUC fees collected monthly shall have to be submitted to the DTO Office. After verification of the same DTO office shall receive the amount & issue money receipt against the amount deposited by AET Station and maintain record of the same in the concern file of Auto Emission Testing Stations.
- 2) The applicants for Pollution Under Control Certificate applying late or applying after expiry of PUC Certificate shall have to be fined by DTO or the authorized officer in this behalf U/S -177 of M.V. Act-1988. In this matter, the AETS shall issue a fresh PUC Certificate & shall direct the applicant by stamping over the PUC Certificate issued thereof as under :

“Instruction : This PUC Certificate is valid only after payment of fine in DTO office u/s-177 of the MV Act, 1988 within 7 (seven) days from the date of issue of this Certificate “

In view of above, you are requested to follow the Guidelines strictly and maintain the record thereof.


